SCRIPTURE READING

Luke 18:1-8

18 ¹⁻³ Jesus told them a story showing that it was necessary for them to pray consistently and never quit. He said, "There was once a judge in some city who never gave God a thought and cared nothing for people. A widow in that city kept after him: 'My rights are being violated. Protect me!'

⁴⁻⁵ "He never gave her the time of day. But after this went on and on he said to himself, 'I care nothing what God thinks, even less what people think. But because this widow won't quit badgering me, I'd better do something and see that she gets justice—otherwise I'm going to end up beaten black-and-blue by her pounding.'"

⁶⁻⁸ Then the Master said, "Do you hear what that judge, corrupt as he is, is saying? So what makes you think God won't step in and work justice for his chosen people, who continue to cry out for help? Won't he stick up for them? I assure you, he will. He will not drag his feet. But how much of that kind of persistent faith will the Son of Man find on the earth when he returns?"

Safety is priority. Inclement weather delays installation.

Speed of installation is based on the number of requests and size of the area impacted.

Steps

- Step 1: Submit application
- Step 2: Application is validated
- Step 3: Damage is assessed
- Step 4: Temporary roof is installed
- Step 5: Temporary roof inspected by USACE

Timeline

After an application is submitted customers may not be contacted prior to assessment or installation. Blue Roof requests are slotted and prioritized to help as many as possible, as quickly as possible. If you have already made arrangements to protect your property and would like to cancel your application, please contact us.

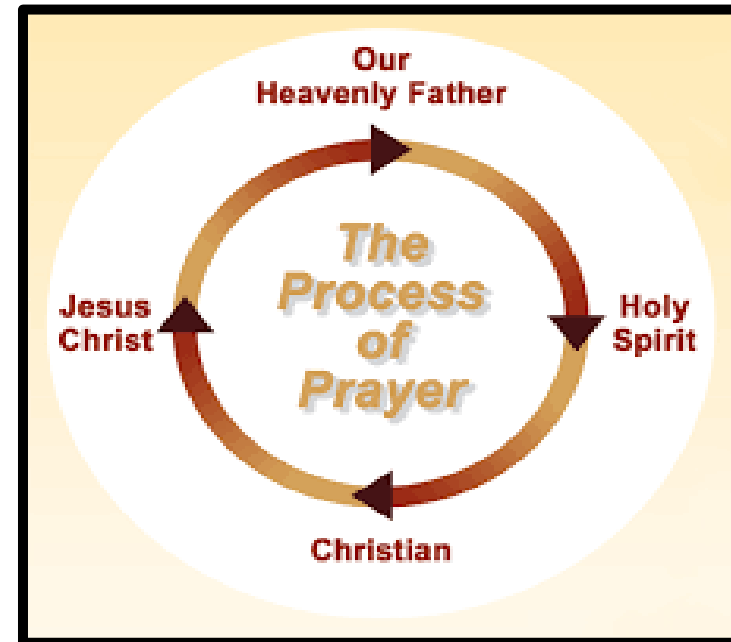
