As they went back down the mountain, he told them not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.

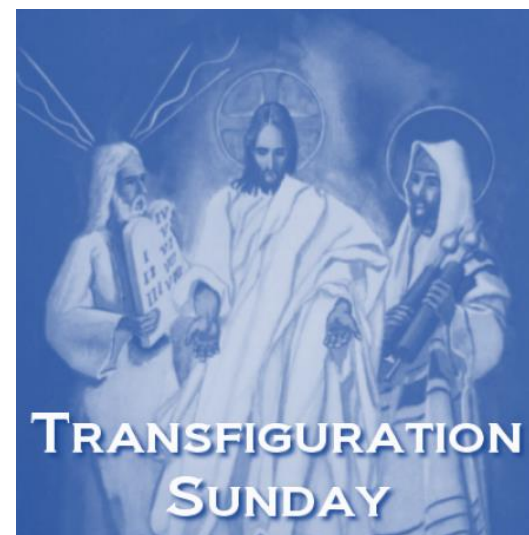
